Did you know?

- 1 in 8 Iowa children are considered food insecure (do not know where their next meal is coming from).
- 139 Iowa communities have Backpack programs serving children in Grades K-6.
- For 11 years the Pella Backpack Program has provided kid friendly, nutritious food for children every Friday during the school year.
- The food tides students over the weekend, so they are better equipped to learn, and behavioral incidents are greatly reduced.
- This year we provide backpack buddies to around 45 students
- Cost is around \$4.00 per sack.
- In addition, Pella groups have also donated hygiene kits and special Christmas packs.
