Young At Heart – Pella Police Presentation






Their passions were very evident as Senior Officer Boertje and Captain Haase from the Pella Police Department gave a presentation to the Young At Heart group from Calvary Church. Senior Officer Boertje spoke to us about the training of K9 Officer Ellie and how she is used by the police department. K9 Officer Ellie is trained in searching for four different types of drugs. She mainly uses her skills in vehicle checks where the officers think drugs are hidden. K9 Officer Ellie is also a tracking dog. Each person carries a particular scent. When K9 Ellie is told what door a person went out of, this amazing dog can find that scent and is able to track that person to where they might be found. If some evidence is found along the way, K9 Officer Ellie will lie down with the evidence between her paws. It was amazing to see the interaction between Senior Officer Boertje and his K9 partner as she searched for the drugs hidden in the room and as she followed the commands of her trainer. K9 Ellie's reward is not food but a special toy ball that she loves to play with.

Captain Haase shared his excitement after graduating from the FBI National Academy in Quantico, VA. "It was a privilege to be nominated for this opportunity," Haase explained. "It was a joy to share this experience with many people from the U.S. along with several other countries." While he was there, about every hot topic in law enforcement was discussed, including an emphasis on the wellness and vitality of the officers. One of the classes Captain Haase attended concentrated on self-care for yourself and the other officers in your agency, anything from mental health, physical fitness, and dealing with the trauma that officers see on a regular basis. Those who attended the academy also visited the Holocausts Museum, the African-American Museum and the Native American Museum. They also went on a tour of the U.S. Capitol and were able to go into the House Chambers. In Philadelphia, they visited Constitutional Hall, where they viewed the Declaration of Independence and the Liberty Bell.

Pella is indeed a privileged community to have all our talented police officers, especially since they are so passionate about their work and the community in which they work.
